

Iowa Regent University Reverse Credit Transfer Worksheet

If you intend to participate in Reverse Credit Transfer to complete an Associates of Arts (AA) or an Associate of Science (AS) degree, you must **complete this form and bring it with you to orientation at your Regent University**, as Regent University advisors are unable to determine the specific courses needed to complete your associate's degree without this form. We recommend working with your community college advisor to complete this form, and you may also bring additional documentation, such as a degree audit or academic evaluation.

What is Reverse Credit Transfer?

Reverse Credit Transfer is a partnership between Iowa's public universities and Iowa's community colleges to facilitate the transfer of university credits back to one of Iowa's community colleges for the purpose of completing a degree, diploma or certificate. Transfer students applying to a Regent University need to have earned 30 or more credit hours from the Iowa community college they most recently attended prior to enrolling at ISU, UNI or UI.

By answering the Reverse Credit Transfer questions on your application to one of the Regent Universities, you are permitting these institutions to send your transcript (at no cost to the student) to the community college.



Reverse Credit Transfer Advising Notes

IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY

The AA degree satisfies all General Education program requirements in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and the Ivy College of Business when the following courses are included:

- The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences requires at least three of the eight hours to be in the humanities, and at least three of the eight hours to be in natural (physical and biological) sciences. The College's world language requirement must also be met.
- The Ivy College of Business requires that general education coursework must include three hours of ethics and three hours in global perspectives.

It is the student's responsibility to have the final, official community college transcript with the notation of the degree sent to Iowa State University's Office of Admissions. Transfer questions should be directed to transfer@iastate.edu or 515-294-5836.



The AA and AS degrees will satisfy all UNIFI requirements. Students do not need to meet specific requirements of UNI's general education requirements (UNIFI) if earning an AA or AS degree.

It is the students' responsibility to have the final community college transcript, with the notation of the degree, diploma, or certificate awarded, sent to the UNI Office of Admissions. Contact UNI Admissions at 319-273-2281 or transfer@uni.edu with any questions.

For the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, Tippie College of Business, College of Education, and University College, the AA degree will satisfy all General Education Program requirements except for:

- Each college's World Language requirement
- Understanding Cultural Perspectives requirement for CLAS and TCOB
- Business/Management or Leadership and Career Development for UC
